

**SOS J. N. Kaul Institute of Education, Bhimtal**  
**Annual Report**  
**(January – December 2020)**

SOS J. N. Kaul Institute of Education, Bhimtal, affiliated to Kumaun University, Nainital is a NAAC Accredited Institute and currently offers B.Ed. programme of two years having 210 approved seats (till date). The students of session 2018-20 have passed in September 2020. Currently the session 2019-21 is running and admission for the session 2020-22 will begin soon.

**Major Activities or Achievements of the Institute:**

The year 2020 posed a different challenge among all educational institutions due to the nationwide lockdown because of COVID-19 pandemic. Though the in-person or face-to-face education was stopped due to lockdown, the Institute never stopped working in these difficult times. The online education and other important activities were carried out effectively by the teaching and non-teaching staff of the Institute. The major activities conducted by the Institute are:

**Impact of Institute on the Village or Community:**

The complete social impact programme of SOS JNKIE was comprised of three modules viz.

1. Adult Literacy
2. e-Governance Literacy
3. Skill Development

Under each module various innovative activities were conducted weekly. The student-teachers were divided into respective groups to conduct innovative activities related to each module in consultation with the faculty members. Apart from the three modules, the social impact programme also focused on organizing constructive and productive programs for various awareness drives, cleanliness drives, blood donation, environment protection, health education, etc.

The social impact programme of SOS JNKIE, Bhimtal emphasised on developing contact with the local community, in which our institute is located, to identify their problems with the help of academic and socio-

economic researches. After gathering of data, the focal areas of the social impact programme of SOS JNKIE were carefully drafted to come out with feasible and positive solutions so that the life of local community members (largely villagers) can be raised to higher levels.
